

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

## **Safety Considerations**

- a. Be aware that the ground is uneven and can at times be slippery, and to be responsible for ensuring funeral attendees are aware and prepared for this
- b. A maximum of 40 people may attend a burial in a new grave, and 20 for an existing grave
- c. No more than six people may backfill the grave at any one time
- d. No more than six people may be within 1.5m of the graveside at any one time
- e. To have at least six pall bearers and to consider bearing the coffin at waist height, rather than shoulder height
- f. To use equipment provided by the grave digger to lower the coffin into the grave
- g. To speak to the Outdoor Services Manager for advice on safe lowering of a coffin

## Other

- h. A maximum of six chairs may be placed by the grave side
- i. Didcot Town Council will arrange the grave digger for a coffin burial, to be paid by the burial contact.
- j. Only a NAMM/BRAMM registered stone mason will be employed to erect a memorial
